## **Spirits**

## No. 6 of 1969

An Act to amend section 3 of the Spirits Act 1906-1968.

[Assented to 8 April 1969]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Spirits Act 1969.
- (2.) The Spirits Act 1906-1968,\* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Spirits Act 1906-1969.

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Interpretation.

- 3. Section 3 of the Spirits Act 1906-1968 is amended—
- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of "Pure Australian Standard Brandy" the word "forty" and inserting in its stead the word "forty-five"; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (a) of the definition of "Australian Blended Brandy" the word "forty" and inserting in its stead the word "forty-five".
