An Act to provide for the Payment of an Annuity to the Widow of the late Senator the Honourable Sir Walter Kingsmill.

Pre amble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Special Annuity Act 1935.
- Annuity to widow of the late Senator the Honourable Sir Walter Kingsmill.

 2.—(1.) Subject to this Act, there shall be payable, out of the Consoli lated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, to the widow of the late Senator the Honourable Sir Walter Kingsmill, an annuity at the rate of One hundred and fifty-six pounds per annum.
 - (2.) The annuity provided by this Act shall cease to be payable in the event of the re-marriage of the annuitant.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Supply Act (No. 2) 1935-36.
- Issue and application of £4,531,540.
- 2. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six the sum of Four million five hundred and thirty-one thousand five hundred and forty pounds out of the

Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied.

3. The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants under sum available the hand of the Governor-General in respect of any purposes and services set forth in the said Schedule.
