# An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of lune One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

[Assented to 22nd November, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :----

**1**. This Act may be cited as the Supply Act (No. 3) 1933-34.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards Issue and application of making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the \$1,485,550. service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four the sum of One million four hundred . and eighty-five thousand five hundred and fifty pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied.

3. The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants under sum available the hand of the Governor-General in respect of any purposes and set for the purposes set forth in the said Schedule services set forth in the said Schedule.

# An Act to suspend the operation of sections three, four and five of the Spirits Act 1932.

[Assented to 24th November, 1933.]

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :--

Short title.

Suspension of operation of Ss. 3, 4 and 5 of Spirite Act 1932. 1. This Act may be cited as the Spirits Act 1933.

2. The operation of sections three, four and five of the Spirits Act 1932\* is hereby suspended until the first day of October One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five and sections three, eleven
