

SUPPLY (No. 3) 1933-34.

No. 22 of 1933.

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

[Assented to 22nd November, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supply Act (No. 3) 1933-34.*

Short title.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four the sum of One million four hundred and eighty-five thousand five hundred and fifty pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied.

Issue and application of £1,485,550.

3. The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants under the hand of the Governor-General in respect of any purposes and services set forth in the said Schedule.

Sum available for the purposes set forth in Schedule.

4. No moneys shall be expended under the authority of this Act after the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

An Act to suspend the operation of sections three, four and five of the *Spirits Act 1932*.

[Assented to 24th November, 1933.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Spirits Act 1933*.

Suspension of operation of Ss. 3, 4 and 5 of *Spirits Act 1932*.

2. The operation of sections three, four and five of the *Spirits Act 1932** is hereby suspended until the first day of October One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five and sections three, eleven
