1918-19.

No. 8 of 1920.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and nineteen.

[Assented to 19th May, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble, and the House of Representatives of the Control of t and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation short title. Act 1918-19.
- 2. The sum of One million sixteen thousand five hundred and Appropriation of ninety-six pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated £1,016,596. Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and nineteen shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 42 of 1918 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.
