

## SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION 1920-21.

### No. 42 of 1921.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.

[ Assented to 22nd December, 1921.]

Preamble.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation Act 1920-21*.

Appropriation

2. The sum of One million two hundred and ninety-four thousand three hundred and twenty-seven pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 42 of 1920 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.
