- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Shale Oil Bounty Act 1917-1923.
- 2. Section two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the Period during words "six years" and inserting in their stead the words "nine payable. vears".
- 3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting specification from sub-section (2.) thereof the words "six years" and inserting in their stead the words "nine years".

4. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended—

Amendment of the Schedule.

- (a) by omitting from the second column the figure "6" and inserting in its stead the figure "9"; and
- (b) by omitting from the fourth column the figures "1923" and inserting in their stead the figures "1926".

SPECIAL ANNUITY.

No. 24 of 1923.

An Act to provide for the Payment of an Annuity to the Widow of the late the Honorable Frank Gwynne Tudor.

[Assented to 1st September, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Special Annuity Act 1923.

Short title.

- 2.—(1.) Subject to this Act, there shall be payable, out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, to the widow of the late the Honorable Frank Gwynne F. G. Tudor. Tudor, an annuity at the rate of One hundred and fifty-six pounds per annum.
- (2.) The annuity provided by this Act shall cease to be payable in the event of the re-marriage of the annuitant.
