### No. 27 of 1928.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Scientific and Industrial Investigation.

### [Assented to 22nd June, 1928.]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:---

1. This Act may be cited as the Science and Industry Appropria- short title. tion Act 1928.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, Appropriation of \$250,000 for which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the scientific and scientific and Trust Account established under the Science and Industry Research research. Act 1920-1926, and known as the Science and Industry Investigation Trust Account, the sum of Two hundred and fifty thousand pounds.
