SPECIAL ANNUITY.

No. 45 of 1936.

An Act to provide for the payment of an Annuity to the Widow of the late William James McWilliams, Esquire.

[Assented to 12th October, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Special Annuity Act 1936.

Short title.

2.—(1.) Subject to this Act, there shall be payable, as on and from Annuity to the first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, widow of the late W. J. out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, to the widow of the late William James McWilliams, Esquire, sometime a member of the House of Representatives, an annuity at the rate of One hundred and fifty-six pounds per annum.

McWilliams.

(2.) The annuity provided by this Act shall cease to be payable in the event of the re-marriage of the annuitant.

APPLE AND PEAR BOUNTY (No. 2).

An Act to amend the Apple and Pear Bounty Act 1936.

[Assented to 12th October, 1936.]

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Apple and Pear Bounty Short title and citation. Act (No. 2) 1936.
