## SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (WORKS AND BUILDINGS) 1901-2 & 1902-3.

### No. 17 of 1903.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for Additions, New Works, and Buildings a further sum for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and two and a further sum for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and three.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1903.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:— Preamble

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation (Works and Buildings) Act* 1901-2 and 1902-3. Short title.

2. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and two, the sum of One thousand and four pounds. Issue and application of £1,004.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and three, the sum of Two thousand six hundred and thirty-five pounds. Issue and application of £2,635.

4. All sums granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and two are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 3 of 1901 for the purposes and services expressed in the First Schedule to this Act. All sums granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and three, are appropriated and shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 10 of 1902 for the purposes and services expressed in the Second Schedule to this Act.
