SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (WORKS AND BUILDINGS) 1914-15.

No. 5 of 1917.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the vear ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and fifteen purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 15th March, 1917.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation short-title. (Works and Buildings) Act 1914-15.

2. The sum of Forty-two thousand six hundred and thirty Appropriation pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for of £42,630. the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and fifteen shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the passing of the Act No. 3 of 1914 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.
