SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION (WORKS AND BUILDINGS) 1932-33.

No. 41 of 1934.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 4th August, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Supplementary Appropriation (Works and Buildings) Act 1932-33.*

2. The sum of Eighty-six thousand five hundred and eighty-four pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Act No. 33 of 1932 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.

DESIGNS.

No. 42 of 1934.

An Act to amend the *Designs Act* 1906-1933.

[Assented to 4th August, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and
citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Designs Act* 1934.

(2.) The *Designs Act* 1906-1933* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Designs Act* 1906-1934.

2. Section seventeen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word "and" and inserting in its stead the word "or".

Duty of owner
of registered
design.

3. Section twenty-nine of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-section:—

"(3.) Where it appears expedient and in the interests of any trade or industry so to do the Governor-General may make regulations dispensing with or modifying the provisions of sub-section (1.) of this section in its application to any class or description of articles to such extent and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit."
