An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c

E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Short title. (Works and Buildings) Act 1936-37.
- 2. The sum of Five hundred and thirty-five thousand six hundred Appropriation of £535,619. and nineteen pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the passing of the Appropriation (Works and Buillings) Act 1936-37 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.

No. 78 of 1938.

An Act to amend the Sales Tax Exemptions Act 1935-1936.

[Assented to 13th December, 1938.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemptions Act 1938.
- (2.) The Sales Tax Exemptions Act 1935-1936,* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Sales Tax Exemptions Act 1935-1938.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
