An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June. One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine. for the purposes of Additions, New Works. Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 4th June, 1940.]

[Date of commencement, 2nd July, 1940.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Short title. (Works and Buildings) Act 1938-39.
- 2. The sum of Ninety-one thousand three hundred and sixty-eight Appropriation of £91,368. pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the commencement of the Appropriation (Works and Buildings) Act 1938-39 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.

NATIONAL SECURITY.

No. 44 of 1940.

An Act to amend the National Security Act 1939.

[Assented to 21st June, 1940.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the National Security Act 1940.
- (2.) The National Security Act 1939* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the National Security Act 1939-1940.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Title.

3. The title of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "the present state of War" and inserting in their stead the words "any War in which His Majesty is or may be engaged".

Definitions.

4. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definitions of "the present state of war" and "the present war".
