BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Short title. (Works and Buildings) Act 1944-45.
- 2. Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1946-47.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Issue and application of £79,393,000.

3. The Treasurer may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply towards making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, the sum of Seventy-nine million three hundred and ninety-three thousand pounds.
