## No. 37 of 1948.

An Act to appropriate a further sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, for the purposes of Additions, New Works, Buildings, &c.

[Assented to 26th June, 1948.] [Date of commencement, 24th July, 1948.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation short title. (Works and Buildings) Act 1946-47.

Appropriation of £617,678.

2. The sum of Six hundred and seventeen thousand six hundred and seventy-eight pounds which has been issued from the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ended the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, shall be deemed to have been appropriated as from the date of the commencement of the Appropriation (Works and Buildings) Act 1946-47 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.

### SOCIAL SERVICES CONSOLIDATION.

#### No. 38 of 1948.

An Act to amend the Social Services Consolidation Act 1947, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 19th October, 1948.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

#### Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Social Services Consolidation Act 1948.
- (2.) The Social Services Consolidation Act 1947\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Social Services Consolidation Act 1947-1948.

#### Commencement

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.
