

SUGAR EXCISE REPEAL.

No. 25 of 1912.

An Act to repeal the Excise Duty on Sugar.

[Assented to 24th December, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Sugar Excise Repeal Act* 1912. Short title.
2. This Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.
3. The *Excise Tariff* 1905 (No. 24 of 1905), the *Excise Tariff (Amendment)* 1906 (No. 15 of 1906), and the *Excise (Sugar) Act* 1910 (No. 17 of 1910), are hereby repealed. Repeal of Sugar Excise.

SUGAR BOUNTY ABOLITION.

An Act to repeal the *Sugar Bounty Act* 1905-1912.

[Assented to 24th December, 1912.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Sugar Bounty Abolition Act* 1912. Short title.
2. This Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.
3. The *Sugar Bounty Act* 1905-1912 is hereby repealed. Repeal of Sugar Bounty Acts.
