2. All duties of Customs demanded or collected on or before the validation of seventh day of December, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, pursuant to the Customs Tariff (Canadian Preference) proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the twenty-second day of May, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, shall be deemed to have been lawfully imposed and lawfully demanded or collected.

STATES' GRANTS.

No. 54 of 1936.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund sums for the purposes of Financial Assistance to the States of the Commonwealth.

[Assented to 23rd November, 1936.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the States' Grants Act 1936.

Short title

2. There shall be payable, for the purposes of financial assistance payment of to the States of New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, South Ausassistance assistance tralia, Western Australia and Tasmania, during the year commencing to the States. on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, the sum of Five hundred thousand pounds.

3. The amount payable to each State under this Act shall be Allocation the amount shown in the following table opposite the name of that of grants. State:-
