## **States Grants (Special Assistance)**

No. 98 of 1967

An Act to grant Financial Assistance to the States of Western Australia and Tasmania.

[Assented to 9 November 1967]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Barray and the H the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia. as follows:----

1. This Act may be cited as the States Grants (Special Assistance) short title. Act 1967.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives Commencement the Royal Assent.

3. There is payable, during the year that commenced on the first day Payment of financial of July. One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, to a State specified assistance in the Schedule to this Act, for the purpose of financial assistance, the Australia and Tasmania. amount specified in that Schedule opposite to the name of that State less any amounts paid to that State in pursuance of section 4 of the States Grants (Special Assistance) Act 1966.

4. The Treasurer may, during the period of six months commencing Advances for year 1968-69. on the first day of July. One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, make advances to the State of Western Australia or the State of Tasmania. for the purpose of financial assistance, of amounts not exceeding in the whole a sum equal to one-half of the amount specified in the Schedule to this Act opposite to the name of that State.

5. Payments in accordance with this Act shall be made out of the Appropriation. Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is appropriated accordingly.
