An Act to amend the States Grants (Advanced Education) Acts 1967.

[Assented to 26 September 1969]

 ${\bf B}^{\rm E}$ it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the States Grants (Advanced Education) Act (No. 2) 1969.

(2.) The States Grants (Advanced Education) Acts 1967* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the States Grants (Advanced Education) Act 1967–1969.

Commencement. 2.--(1.) Subject to this section, this Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

(2.) The amendment made by the next succeeding section shall be deemed to have taken effect on the first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven.
