STATES GRANTS (SPECIAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE).

No. 10 of 1951.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund sums for the purposes of Financial Assistance to the States.

[Assented to 29th June, 1951.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the States Grants (Special Financial Assistance) Act 1951.

Short title.

- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencemen. receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. There shall be payable to the States, during the year which commenced on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred assistance the sum of Fifteen to States. and fifty, for the purposes of financial assistance, the sum of Fifteen million pounds.

4. The amount payable to each State under this Act is the amount Allocation of grant. shown in the following table opposite the name of that State:-

5. Payments in accordance with this Act shall be made out of Appropriation. the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly.
