

WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT REPEAL.

No. 39 of 1922.

An Act to amend section seven of the *War Precautions Act Repeal Act 1920-1921.*

[Assented to 18th October, 1922.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *War Precautions Act Repeal Act 1922.*

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *War Precautions Act Repeal Act 1920-1921*, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *War Precautions Act Repeal Act 1920-1922.*

2. Section seven of the *War Precautions Act Repeal Act 1920-1921* is amended by omitting from the proviso thereto the words "One thousand nine hundred and twenty-two" and inserting in their stead the words "One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three".

Amendment of s. 7.

SHALE OIL BOUNTY.

No. 40 of 1922.

An Act to amend the *Shale Oil Bounty Act 1917-1921.*

[Assented to 18th October, 1922.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Preamble.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Shale Oil Bounty Act 1922.*

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Shale Oil Bounty Act 1917-1921* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Shale Oil Bounty Act 1917-1922.*

Amendment of
s. 2.

2. Section two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "five years" and inserting in their stead the words "six years".

Specification
of bounty.

3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from sub-section (2.) thereof the words "five years" and inserting in their stead the words "six years".

Amendment
of the Schedule.

4. The Schedule to the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from the second column the figure "5" and inserting in its stead the figure "6";
- (b) by omitting from the second column the figures and letter "2¼d." and inserting in their stead the figures and letter "3½d."; and
- (c) by omitting from the fourth column the figures "1922" and inserting in their stead the figures "1923".

BRITISH EMPIRE EXHIBITION APPROPRIATION.

No. 41 of 1922.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of One hundred and fifteen thousand pounds to provide for the representation of the Commonwealth at the British Empire Exhibition 1924.

[Assented to 18th October, 1922.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *British Empire Exhibition Appropriation Act 1922*.

Appropriation
of £115,000.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purpose of providing for the representation of the Commonwealth at the British Empire Exhibition to be held at Wembley Park, Middlesex, England, during the year One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, the sum of One hundred and fifteen thousand pounds.
