# INVALID AND OLD-AGE PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

### No. 2 of 1940.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for Invalid and Old-age Pensions.

[Assented to 17th May, 1940.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Appropriation Act 1940.

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Appropriation of £17,000,000 for invalid and old-age pensions.

3. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act* 1901–1934 and known as the Invalid and Old-age Pensions Fund, the sum of Seventeen million pounds for invalid and old-age pensions.

An Act to amend the Sales Tax Act (No. 1) 1930-1939.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title nd citation. 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Sales Tax Act (No. 1) 1940.

(2.) The Sales Tax Act (No. 1) 1930-1939,\* as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Sales Tax Act (No. 1) 1930-1940.

Act No. 26, 1930, as amended by No. 63, 1930; No. 26, 1931; No. 32, 1936; No. 30, 1938; and No. 16, 1939.

- 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it commencement. receives the Royal Assent.
- 3. Section three of the Sales Tax Act (No. 1) 1930-1939 is Imposition of amended---
  - (a) by omitting the words and figures "on or after the 9th September, 1939" and inserting in their stead the words and figures "during the period commencing on the 9th September, 1939, and terminating on the 2nd May, 1940"; and
  - (b) by adding at the end thereof the words and figures "on or after the 3rd May, 1940 .. .. 8½ per centum.".

  - (a) by omitting the words and figures "on or after the 9th September, 1939" and inserting in their stead the words and figures "during the period commencing on the 9th September, 1939, and terminating on the 2nd May, 1940"; and
  - (b) by adding at the end thereof the words and figures "on or after the 3rd May, 1940 ...  $8\frac{1}{3}$  per centum.".
