## 'An Act to amend sections three and six of the Sales Tax Assessment Act (No. 3) 1930.

[Assented to 16th December, 1930.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the Sales Tax Assessment Act Short title and (No. 3A) 1930.

- (2.) The Sales Tax Assessment Act (No. 3) 1930\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Sales Tax Assessment Acts (No. 3) 1930.
- 2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of commencement. the commencement of the Principal Act.
  - 3. Section three of the Principal Act is amended—

Sales tax.

- inserting, after the word "Australia", the words ", either before or after the commencement of this Act,";
- (b) by inserting, after the word "sold", the words "on or after the first day of August One thousand nine hundred and thirty ".
- 4. Section six of the Principal Act is amended—

Exemptions.

- (a) by inserting at the end of paragraph (b) the word "or";
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) the word "or"; and
- (c) by omitting paragraph (d).
