

WESTERN AUSTRALIA GRANT.

No. 36 of 1934.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the purposes of Financial Assistance to the State of Western Australia.

[Assented to 4th August, 1934.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Western Australia Grant Act* 1934.

Payment for financial assistance to Western Australia.

2. There shall be payable, for the purposes of financial assistance to the State of Western Australia, during the year commencing on the first day of July One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, the sum of Six hundred thousand pounds.

Method of payment.

3. The amount payable under this Act shall be paid in equal monthly instalments.

Appropriation.

4. Payments in accordance with this Act shall be made out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly.

TASMANIA GRANT.

No. 37 of 1934.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the purposes of Financial Assistance to the State of Tasmania.

[Assented to 4th August, 1934.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Tasmania Grant Act* 1934.

2. There shall be payable, for the purposes of financial assistance to the State of Tasmania, during the year commencing on the first day of July One thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, the sum of Four hundred thousand pounds.

Payment for financial assistance to Tasmania.

3. The amount payable under this Act shall be paid in equal monthly instalments.

Method of payment.

4. Payments in accordance with this Act shall be made out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly.

Appropriation.

STATES GRANTS.

No. 38 of 1934.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund sums for the purposes of Financial Assistance to the States of the Commonwealth.

[Assented to 4th August, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *States Grants Act* 1934.

Short title.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purpose of financial assistance to the States during the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, the sum of Two million pounds.

Appropriation of £2,000,000 for financial assistance to the States.

3. The amount payable to each State under this Act shall be the amount shown in the following table opposite the name of that State.

4. The amount payable to any State under this Act shall be paid to that State at such times and in such manner as the Treasurer approves.

Time and manner of payment.
