BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Western Australia Grant Act Short title. 1936.
- 2. There shall be payable, for the purposes of financial assistance Payment for to the State of Western Australia, during the year commencing on financial assistance the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, Australia. the sum of Five hundred thousand pounds.

Short fitle.

Payment for financial assistance to Tasmania. 2. There shall be payable, for the purposes of financial assistance to the State of Tasmania, during the year commencing on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, the sum of Six hundred thousand pounds.

Method of payment.

3. The amount payable under this Act shall be paid in equal monthly instalments.

Appropriation.

4. Payments in accordance with this Act shall be made out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA GRANT.

Payment for financial assistance to South Australia. 2. There shall be payable, for the purposes of financial assistance to the State of South Australia, during the year commencing on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, the sum of One million three hundred and thirty thousand pounds.

Method of payment.

3. The amount payable under this Act shall be paid in equal monthly instalments.

Appropriation.

4. Payments in accordance with this Act shall be made out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly.
