Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Authority to borrow £200,000,000. 3. The Treasurer may, from time to time, borrow, under the provisions of the *Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act* 1911–1940, or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Two hundred million pounds.

Purposes for which money may be expended. 4. The amount borrowed may be issued and applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for the purposes of appropriations made, or to be made, by law.

Issue and application of £200,000,000.

5. There may be issued and applied out of the proceeds of any loan raised under the authority of this Act, or of any other Act, the sum of Two hundred million pounds for war purposes.

## TASMANIA GRANT.

## No. 25 of 1943.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the purpose of Financial Assistance to the State of Tasmania.

[Assented to 29th June, 1943.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Tasmania Grant Act 1943.
- commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. There shall be payable to the State of Tasmania, in respect of Payment for the year which commenced on the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and forty-two, for the purposes of financial assistance, State of Tasmania in addition to the sum granted by the States Grants Act 1942, the sum of Two hundred thousand pounds.

4. Payment in accordance with this Act shall be made out of the Appropriation. Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly.

An Act to grant and apply a sum out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and forty-four.

There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards Issue and making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service \$\frac{23,889,000}{243,889,000}\$. of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and forty-four the sum of Forty-three million eight hundred and eighty-nine thousand pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized to be issued and applied.

4. The sum specified in the last preceding section shall be available to satisfy the warrants under the hand of the Governor-General in respect of any purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act.
