An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and nine.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, Preamble. and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Supply Act (No. 1) 1908-9.

2. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards application of making good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the service $\pm 1,412,625$. of the year ending the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and nine the sum of One million four hundred and twelve thousand six hundred and twenty-five pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Act, and the Treasurer is hereby and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorized authorized to be issued and applied.
