

## WAR LOAN.

### No. 23 of 1917.

An Act to authorize the raising and expending of the sum of Eighty million pounds for War purposes.

[Assented to 15th September, 1917.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *War Loan Act 1917*.

Short title and citation.

2. The Treasurer may from time to time, under the provisions of the *Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1915*, or under the provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole the sum of Eighty million pounds.

Authority to borrow  
£80,000,000.

3. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for the expenses of borrowing and for War purposes.

Purpose for which money may be borrowed.

## WAR LOAN (UNITED KINGDOM).

### No. 24 of 1917.

An Act to amend the *War Loan (United Kingdom) Act 1914-1916* and the *War Loan (United Kingdom) Act 1915-1916*.

[Assented to 20th September, 1917.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *War Loan (United Kingdom) Act 1917*.

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *War Loan (United Kingdom) Act 1914-1916* as amended by this Act may be cited as the *War Loan (United Kingdom) Act 1914-1917*.
