WAR LOAN (No. 3).

No. 50 of 1915.

An Act to authorize the raising and expending of the sum of Eighteen million pounds for War purposes.

[Assented to 15th November, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the War Loan Act (No. 3) 1915.

Short title.

2. The Treasurer may from time to time, under the provisions Treasurer may of the Commonwealth Inscribed Stock Act 1911-1915 or under the borrow £18,000,000. provisions of any Act authorizing the issue of Treasury Bills, borrow moneys not exceeding in the whole the amount of Eighteen million pounds.

3. The amount borrowed shall be issued and applied only for Purpose for which money may be borrowed. the expenses of borrowing and for War purposes.
