# WAR PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

#### No. 25 of 1925.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for War Pensions.

## [Assented to 26th September, 1925.]

Preamble.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the War Pensions Appropriation Act 1925.

Appropriation of £10,000,000 for war pensions.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act* 1901–1924, and known as the War Pensions Fund, the sum of Ten million pounds for war pensions.

### WAR SERVICE HOMES.

#### No. 26 of 1925.

An Act to amend paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.) of section twelve of the War Service Homes Act 1918-1923.

[Assented to 26th September, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the War Service Homes Ac 1925.
- (2.) The War Service Homes Act 1918-1923\*, as amended by thi Act, may be cited as the War Service Homes Act 1918-1925.
