

## WAR PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

### No. 43 of 1926.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for War Pensions.

[Assented to 16th August, 1926.]

Preamble.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *War Pensions Appropriation Act* 1926.

Appropriation  
of £10,000,000  
for war  
pensions.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act* 1901–1926, and known as the War Pensions Fund, the sum of Ten million pounds for war pensions.

## INVALID AND OLD-AGE PENSIONS.

### No. 44 of 1926.

An Act to amend sections sixteen and twenty-one of the *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Act* 1908–1925.

[Assented to 16th August, 1926.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

Short title  
and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Act* 1926.

(2.) The *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Act* 1908–1925\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
