

WAR PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

No. 43 of 1943.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for War Pensions.

[Assented to 30th September, 1943.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the *War Pensions Appropriation Act 1943*.

Short title.

2. This Act shall come into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Commencement.

3. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act 1901-1934* and known as the War Pensions Fund, the sum of Ten million pounds for war pensions.

Appropriation of £10,000,000 for war pensions.

An Act to amend the *Sales Tax (Exemptions and Classifications) Act 1935-1943*.

[Assented to 19th October, 1943.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Sales Tax (Exemptions and Classifications) Act (No. 2) 1943*.
