

## WAR PENSIONS APPROPRIATION.

### No. 25 of 1925.

An Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for War Pensions.

[Assented to 26th September, 1925.]

Preamble.

**BE** it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, for the purpose of appropriating the grant originated in the House of Representatives, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *War Pensions Appropriation Act 1925*.

Appropriation of £10,000,000 for war pensions.

2. There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, which is hereby appropriated accordingly, for the purposes of the Trust Account established under the *Audit Act 1901-1924*, and known as the War Pensions Fund, the sum of Ten million pounds for war pensions.

## WAR SERVICE HOMES.

### No. 26 of 1925.

An Act to amend paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.) of section twelve of the *War Service Homes Act 1918-1923*.

[Assented to 26th September, 1925.]

**BE** it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows :—

Short title and citation.

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *War Service Homes Act 1925*.

(2.) The *War Service Homes Act 1918-1923\**, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *War Service Homes Act 1918-1925*.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the twelfth day of August One thousand nine hundred and twenty-five. Commencement

3. Section twelve of the *War Service Homes Act 1918-1923* is amended by inserting in paragraph (a) of sub-section (1.) thereof, after the word "employment", the following words "(not being employment in the Public Service of the Commonwealth)". Office of

## INVALID AND OLD-AGE PENSIONS.

### No. 27 of 1925.

An Act to amend sections twenty-four, thirty-one, forty-five and forty-seven of the *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Act 1908-1923*.

[ Assented to 26th September, 1925.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, the Senate, and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Australia, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Act may be cited as the *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Act 1925*. Short title and  
citation.

(2.) The *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Act 1908-1923\** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3.) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Invalid and Old-age Pensions Act 1908-1925*.

2. This Act shall commence on the eighth day of October One thousand nine hundred and twenty-five. Commencement

3. Section twenty-four of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1.) thereof the words "Forty-five pounds ten shillings" (wherever occurring) and inserting in their stead the words "Fifty-two pounds"; and

(b) by omitting from sub-section (1.) thereof the words "Seventy-eight pounds" and inserting in their stead the words "Eighty-four pounds ten shillings". Limit of  
pension.
