LODGING-HOUSE REPEAL ORDINANCE 1973

No. 35 of 1973

An Ordinance to provide that certain laws of the State of South Australia relating to lodging-houses shall cease to apply to the Territory

[Assented to 12 July, 1973]

DE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern B Territory of Australia as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Lodging-house short title Repeal Ordinance 1973.
- 2. The laws of the State of South Australia specified in the Schedule cease to apply to the Territory as laws of the Australia to cease to apply Territory.
