

LODGING-HOUSE REPEAL ORDINANCE 1973

1505

No. 35 of 1973

An Ordinance to provide that certain laws of the
State of South Australia relating to
lodging-houses shall cease to apply to the Territory

[Assented to 12 July, 1973]

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern
Territory of Australia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Lodging-house* Short title
Repeal Ordinance 1973.

2. The laws of the State of South Australia specified in
the Schedule cease to apply to the Territory as laws of the
