TRAFFIC ORDINANCE 1972

No. 23 of 1972

An Ordinance to amend the *Traffic* Ordinance 1949 as amended

[Assented to 12 July, 1972]

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory of Australia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Traffic Ordinance Short title 1972.

2. The Traffic Ordinance 1949 as amended is in this Ordi-Principal Ordinance nance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

3. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to Commencement be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette.*

4. Section 31 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Motor cycle drivers and omitting from sub-section (2.) the words "a protective helmet of villion riders a type approved by the Administrator in Council" and inserting in their stead the following words "a protective helmet of a prescribed type".

5. Section 57 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by Regulations omitting paragraph (i) and inserting in its stead the following paragraphs:----

- "(i) types of protective helmets to be worn by drivers of motor cycles and pillion riders;
- (*j*) the imposition of penalties not exceeding One hundred dollars for breaches of the regulations.".
