Rules of Court under the Legal Practitioners (Trust Accounts) Ordinance 1930.

Amendments of the Legal Practitioners (Trust Accounts) Rules of Court.

- 1. The Rules of Court made under the Legal Practitioners (Trust Accounts) Ordinance 1930 and notified in the Northern Territory Government Gazette on the fifth day of July, 1950, may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Trust Accounts) Rules of Court.
- 2. Rule 2 of the Legal Practitioners (Trust Accounts) Rules of Court is amended—
 - (a) by omitting the definition of "Clerk"; and
 - (b) by inserting after the word "intended—" the following definition:—
 - "Master" means the Master of the Supreme Court and includes a Deputy Master of the Supreme Court".
- 3. Rule 4 of the Legal Practitioners (Trust Accounts) Rules of Court is amended by omitting the proviso to sub-rule (1.) and inserting in its stead the following proviso:—
- "Provided that if within the said period of three days the practitioner so requires, or if after the expiration of the said period of three days the practitioner is still guilty of the said breach, the Master shall submit the facts to the Judge and the Master and the practitioner shall thereupon abide by such directions as the Judge may give".
- 4. The Legal Practitioners (Trust Accounts) Rules of Court are amended as set out in the Schedule to these Rules.
