An Act to amend "The Bread Act, 1891."

[Assented to, December 23rd, 1893.]

DE it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Bread Act Amendment Act, Short title. 1893."

2. Section 3 of "The Bread Act, 1891," is hereby repealed.

3. The expression "standard weight" when used in "The Bread Standard weight, Act, No. 530 of 1891," in reference to bread shall mean a loaf of the full weight of two pounds avoirdupois weight.

4. In section 10 of "The Bread Act, 1891," shall be read after Penalty for subthe word "pay" in the fourth line of the said section the words "for a first offence," and the following words shall be read at the end and as forming part of the said section "and for each subsequent offence any sum not exceeding Ten Pounds."

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
