**An Act to amend the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act, 1968.**

*[Assented to 22nd April, 1971]*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

**1. (1)** This Act may be cited as the "Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act Amendment Act, 1971".

**(2)** The Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act, 1968, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act, 1968-1971".

**(3)** The Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act, 1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

**2.** This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
