## No. 264.

An Act to further amend "The Bush Fires Act, 1864."

[Assented to, November 17th, 1882.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Bush Fires Preamble. Act, 1864 "—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The Time for burning Bush Fires Act, 1864," or the Act No. 15 of 1874, to amend "The stubble and scrub. Bush Fires Act, 1864," during the months of February, March, and April stubble and scrub may be burnt outside the limits of District Councils at any time between sunrise and sunset.

- 2. No fire for the burning of stubble or scrub shall be lighted space to be cleared. unless a space of at least half a chain in width shall have been ploughed or cleared of scrub, surrounding the block or field proposed to be burnt.
- 3. This Act and "The Bush Fires Act, 1864," shall be incor- Incorporation. porated and be read therewith as one Act.
