An Act to amend the Business Franchise (Tobacco) Act, 1974-1978.

[Assented to 18th June, 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Business Franchise (Tobacco) Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1981".
- (2) The Business Franchise (Tobacco) Act, 1974-1978, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Business Franchise (Tobacco) Act, 1974-1981".

Amendment of s. 11—

- 2. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out paragraphs (a) and (ab) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraphs:
 - (a) for a wholesale tobacco merchant's licence—a fee of ten dollars together with—
 - (i) in the case of a licence that commences before the first day of August, 1981, an amount of 10 per centum;
 - (ii) in the case of a licence that commences on or after the first day of August, 1981, an amount of 12.5 per centum,

of the value of tobacco sold by the applicant in the course of tobacco wholesaling during the relevant period;

- (ab) for a group wholesale tobacco merchant's licence—a fee of ten dollars together with—
 - (i) in the case of a licence that commences before the first day of August, 1981, an amount of 10 per centum;

(ii) in the case of a licence that commences on or after the first day of August, 1981, an amount of 12.5 per centum,

of the value of tobacco sold by all persons who are members of the group of wholesale tobacco merchants of which the applicant for the licence, or renewal of the licence, is a member (whether or not the application was made by them or on their behalf and whether or not they were members of that group during the whole or any part of the relevant period) in the course of tobacco wholesaling during the relevant period.;

and

(b) by striking out from paragraph (b) of subsection (1) the passage "ten per centum" and substituting the passage "12.5 per centum".
