**An Act to amend the Barley Marketing Act,
1947-1952.**

[Assented to 15th November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Barley Marketing Act Amendment Act, 1956". Short titles.

(2) The Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1952, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1956".

(3) The Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1952, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "the next succeeding section" and inserting in lieu thereof "section 15 of this Act". Amendment of s. 14 of principal Act—Sale and delivery of barley.

4. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 14 thereof :— Enactment of s. 14a of principal Act—

14a. (1) A person shall not buy barley from the grower thereof except with the written approval of the board. Purchase of barley from growers.

(2) This section shall not apply to a purchase of barley in the course of trade commerce or intercourse between States.

5. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (2) thereof the following subsection :—

(3) Proceedings for offences against this Act or the regulations shall be disposed of summarily.

Amendment of
s. 22 of

principal Act.

6. Section 22 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the figures "1957-1958" at the end thereof and inserting in lieu thereof "1962-1963".
