An Act to amend the Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1978.

[Assented to 20th March, 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Barley Marketing Act Amendment short titles. Act, 1980".
- (2) The Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1980".
 - 2. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended—

principal Act

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "after the appointed sale and delivery of barley."

and

- (b) by striking out subsection (3).
- 3. Section 14aa of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "after the appointed sale and delivery day";
- (b) by striking out paragraph (f) of subsection (2) and the word "or" immediately preceding that paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraphs:—
 - (f) oats sold to a person who purchases the oats for the purpose of—
 - (i) converting the oats into chopped, crushed, or milled oats or any other manufactured product;

and

(ii) reselling the oats in that form;

(g) oats sold to a person who purchases the oats for his own use and not for resale;

and

(c) by striking out subsection (3).
