An Act to amend the Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1978.

[Assented to 20th March, 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Barley Marketing Act Amendment Act, 1980". Short titles.

(2) The Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Barley Marketing Act, 1947-1980".

2. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "after the appointed day";

and

(b) by striking out subsection (3).

Amendment of principal Act, s. 14—
Sale and delivery of barley.

3. Section 14aa of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "after the appointed day";

(b) by striking out paragraph (f) of subsection (2) and the word "or" immediately preceding that paragraph and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraphs:—

(f) oats sold to a person who purchases the oats for the purpose of—

(i) converting the oats into chopped, crushed, or milled oats or any other manufactured product;

and

(ii) reselling the oats in that form;

or

(g) oats sold to a person who purchases the oats for his own use and not for resale;

and

(c) by striking out subsection (3).
