An Act to amend the Constitution.

[Reserved, December 21st, 1899.]

E it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Constitution Amendment Act, Short title and incor-1899," and shall be incorporated with "The Constitution Act" and poration. its amendments.

2. No Member of either House of the Parliament of the Disqualification of Commonwealth of Australia shall be qualified for nomination or Federal members for local Parliament. election as a Member of either House of the Parliament of South Australia.

3. If any Member of either House of the Parliament of South Members of local Australia shall be elected a Member of either House of the Parlia-Parliament to vacate seats on sitting in ment of the Commonwealth of Australia he shall vacate his seat in Federal Parliament. the Parliament of South Australia on taking his seat in the Parliament of the Commonwealth.
