An Act to amend the Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1948.

[Assented to 4th October, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1951".
- (2) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1948, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1951".
- (3) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1948, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Definition of disease.

- 2. The definition of "disease" in subsection (1) of section 4 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by inserting after the word "tuberculosis" the word "trichomoniasis";
 - (b) by inserting after the word "actinomycosis" the passage "(including actinobacillosis and other affections with club formations)".
