An Act to amend the Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1951.

[Assented to 2nd December, 1954.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1954".
- (2) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1954".
- (3) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1951, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 13—
Duty on sales of cattle.

- 2. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out the words "three farthings" in the sixth line of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one halfpenny";
 - (b) by striking out the words "tenpence half-penny:
 Provided further that if the amount of any cattle
 stamp duty payable in respect of the sale of any
 cattle does not consist of a multiple of one-halfpenny,
 the amount of cattle stamp duty so payable shall

be the amount which would otherwise be payable pursuant to this section plus one farthing" in subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "three pence".
