An Act to amend the Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1968.

*[Assented to 5th November, 1970]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1970".

(2) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1968, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1970".

(3) The Cattle Compensation Act, 1939-1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 6—  
Amount of compensation.

2. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and the proviso thereto and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(1) Subject to this Act, on and after the commencement of the Cattle Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1970, the amount of compensation payable pursuant to this Act in respect of cattle—

(a) destroyed by or by order of an inspector pursuant to any Act or any regulation or proclamation under any Act, because the cattle are suffering from or suspected of suffering from disease;

or

(b) destroyed with the consent of the chief inspector, because the cattle are suffering from or suspected of suffering from disease,

shall be the market value (subject to such deductions as are hereinafter in this Act specified) of the cattle.

3. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the word “The” being the first word in the subsection and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “Subject to this section, the market”;

(b) by inserting in subsection (1) before the word “value” secondly occurring the word “market”;

and

(c) by inserting after subsection (3) the following subsection:—

(4) For the purposes of—

(a) this section;

and

(b) any scale prescribed for the purposes of subsection (2) of section 6 of this Act,

where the market value of any head of cattle or carcass exceeds two hundred dollars the market value of that head of cattle or, as the case may be, carcass shall be deemed to be two hundred dollars.
