An Act to amend the Criminal Injuries Compensation Act, 1978.

[Assented to 8 September 1988]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Criminal Injuries Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1988.

(2) The Criminal Injuries Compensation Act, 1978, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will be taken to have come into operation on 1 July, 1978.

Insertion of s. 14a

3. The following section is inserted after section 14 of the principal Act:

Date as at which compensation is to be assessed

14a. Where a person is entitled to compensation under this Act, the amount of the compensation must be assessed in accordance with the provisions of this Act as in force at the time of the commission of the offence from which the injury arose.
